Here are a few thoughts from me:

we should not be bounced into an over-hasty reply - unless someone can see a tactical advantage in replying tomorrow

- we should treat this, and any further requests for information, in the same way as an FoI request swiftly (within 20 days), efficiently, and within reasonable cost limits
- check for precedents and elephant traps with DCA the owners of FoI and wider legal, constitutional and "inquiry" issues
- MS(PH) should offer to meet Lord Archer in due course, if he would care to call
- Lord Archer may wish to put in FoI requests
- no-one from DH should attend as a "witness"
- consider whether a DH official should observe proceedings from the public gallery.
