As per your recent meeting with MS(PH) regarding Lord Archer' Independent Inquiry into contaminated NHS blood and blood products.

Action Points

- Are there comparable issues in OGDs? Why do these issues differ? What kind of financial relief do those affected by issues in OGDs receive? What is the reasoning behind this level of relief? What kind of lobbying is associated with these issues?
- Redrafting correspondence lines. You agreed with MS(PH) that the current lines are too long and will need to be edited for response to letters.
