I refer to Mr Wrigglesworth's minute of 28 June 1983. His survey does leave a few questions about which I am not entirely clear. For example, I understood the March 1983 FDA "rules" were in the nature of a request to centres which were already "licensed". If this is so, a statement from the company that they collect only from licensed centres may not fully answer our worry. In some instances we are still left with the backlog of uncertain plasma or of Factor VIII. "Future sales" is a rather vague term. Does this mean from this moment on or from some date yet to be determined. You will no doubt be considering the reports in greater detail on your return from leave. In view of the reasonably reassuring information I do not imagine we would wish to take any precipitate action although I suppose we would prefer not to receive any Immuno's pre-March 1983 quarantined plasma.
