For your information, I enclose copies of:-

- 1) His bleeding episodes, transfusions and prophylaxis so far this term
- 2) Orthopaedic chart
- 3) Laboratory results

GRO-A is on alternate day 20% raise for targeting into his left knee. This prophylactic course was started on 20.5.83 and will continue until the end of term. He has not attended physiotherapy this term with a resultant loss in extension of both knees and left elbow.

AIDS RELATED INVESTIGATIONS:

Clinically he exhibits some of the stigmata of AIDS i.e. he has had throat pains and difficulty in swallowing and shortness of breath for more than one week in the past. He has also lost 4 kg. in body weight this term. Examination of his superficial lymph nodes on 28.2.83 revealed palpable bilateral inguinal lymph nodes. When we re-examined him on 23.6.83 there was also a palpable small right tonsillar and tiny left supraclavicular lymph node.

For your information we have undertaken the enclosed AIDS related tests. We have repeated these tests and will let you have the results when they are available.
