CENTRAL BLOOD LABORATORIES

PC(1) has seen Mr Hodder's minute of 29 May and the attached submission. He is unhappy with the proposal that a special health authority should be established to manage the central blood laboratories. He has commented:

"I prefer the North-West Thames option. ^{para 13-15} I don't like the idea of more special health authorities - they increase the interface problems, and this one would be very small. This service is an integral part of the NHS and I believe the existing structure is flexible and capable enough to run it."
