Dear Charlie

We have support from the Group to top slice money from the recombinant budget for a project/data manager whose job description is, as you say, directly linked to the roll out. There was inevitably sensitivity from the patient rep to the idea of using this money to support a UKHCDO post. It will therefore be important to demonstrate that the post will be of direct benefit to patients by pointing up the difference it make to the effective management of the roll out. After the meeting I asked Frank for a job description and a set of measurable objectives for the post. Is there any chance that you can get these to me this week? As soon as we can agree the details, the money can be made available.

I appreciate the enormous efforts that you and your colleagues have already put into making this process work and the pressures you are under. Given the complexities of the situation and the need to move ahead quickly, it is crucial that we get a dedicated person in post as soon as possible and I will make sure that this is not delayed at this end. Your other questions are going to have to wait for my successor - Richard Gutowski - to pick up. He starts on 9 June so there won't be huge gap.

Many thanks for all your help and support. Hopefully our paths will cross again in future.
