The letter of 4 December from the Inter-Regional Secretariat refers.

- 2. A discussion in January of just one option would be inappropriate. The report makes out a powerful case for some change. My personal view is that a SHA run service is unlikely to be the right approach. However Ministers ought to have the opportunity of considering this option amongst others in the context of the report as a whole.
- 3. The suggested way forward is that after taking advice from the Advisory Committee on the NBTS we will prepare a paper presenting the report and options for change to the HPSS PC (February), NHSMB, and then Ministers. A discussion paper on the suggested way forward together with a copy of the report would then be widely circulated for discussion.
- 4. This seems preferable to sending out the report itself for consultation and then having to do the same again in respect of the preferred option. A consensus is unlikely to form round the options in the report.
- 5. I attach a draft reply.
