1. I have been away so I have only just seen your minute of 21 February to Mr. D.U. Jackson and there is one additional point I should like to make.
2. In paragraph 5 (iv) you correctly point out that we should both be involved before commitments are undertaken. In the future it is also essential that H.S.I. are consulted.
3. Paragraphs 1 and 7 of your minute imply that it is proposed to expand the production of the A.H.G. Concentrate and that the full year cost in 1974/5 will be higher than 1973/4. The reductions in public expenditure have been so severe that R.H.As will be unable to carry through all the projects that the Department would like to see. H.S.I. are therefore co-ordinating the priority aspects and they will have to be consulted before R.H.As are committed.
