Interim Guidelines on Aquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome - AIDS

I am in reciept of the above document dated January 1985. As a haemophilia Director with a large haemophilia practice at Manchester Royal Infirmary, I would like clarification of the measures required for dealing with blood samples of patients with haemophilia.

My two questions, specifically are:

- In the absence of results of anti-HTLV3 tests being available, should I assume that each of my haemophiliacs comes into the categories described in 35. 'patients in whom AIDS or PGL is suspected or has been diagnosed'?
- 2 Do samples from these patients meet the requirements described in 36, where containment level 3 facilities for manual work are required?

An early reply to these two questions would be appreciated.
