We are now able to offer AIDS virus antibody testing (anti-HTLV3) to all patients with bleeding disorders who have been treated with plasma, cryoprecipitate or concentrated clotting factors since 1980.

I would strongly recommend that we test your blood and suggest that you call at the Clinical Haematology department any day Monday to Friday between 9am and 4.30pm or by arrangement on a Saturday morning.
