ARMOUR FACTOR VIII Batch No. X47207

Please note that a single bottle containing 540 IU of  
Factor VIII was given to [REDACTED] on 18 May 1984,  
a patient with Von Willebrand's disorder, who has  
subsequently developed HTLV3 positive antibodies. As  
the only other blood product that he has had was cryo-  
precipitate, one can assume that the positivity is due  
to the commercial Factor VIII. I would think under the  
circumstances, if there were any supplies left from this  
batch, then they should be treated as infected material.
