Please note that a single bottle containing 540 IU of Factor VIII was given to an 18 May 1984, a patient with Von Willebrand's disorder, who has subsequently developed HTLV3 positive antibodies. As the only other blood product that he has had was cryoprecipitate, one can assume that the positivity is due to the commercial Factor VIII. I would think under the circumstances, if there were any supplies left from this batch, then they should be treated as infected material.
