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My query concerning the statement of inactivation of Non-A, Non-B hepatitis related to the tabular presentation of the results. The paragraph preceding the table seems to indicate that the levels were all quantitatively measured in in-vitro studies. We know that Non-A, Non-B hepatitis inactivation was studied in chimpanzees and this should be made clear. Perhaps this could be done by adding a reference to the studies in chimpanzees after the statement "Virus inactivated by lyophilisation and heat-treatment process".

I thought the presentation of these results was slightly misleading.
