Attached is a copy of correspondence between Professor Ingram and myself concerning a recent case of jaundice in his hospital. In accordance with the terms of our Product Licence, I have notified the Department of Health accordingly.

I am somewhat concerned at the two batch numbers referred to in the letter from Professor Ingram, since all of batch 0591A032AI should have been re-labelled as 010575 in Lessines before shipment to the U.K. There should therefore be no way in which Ingram could have seen the Hyland batch number unless, 1) some U.S. labelled product was shipped into the U.K., 2) some mislabelling of product has taken place in Lessines.

Whilst I will endeavour to check the situation at this end, I would appreciate it if you and Robert Taub can investigate these possibilities in the U.S. and Belgium respectively.
