- 1. 28 cases. Mainly haemophilia (factor VIII or factor IX deficiency), a few cases of von Willebrand's disease and one of thrombasthenia.
- 2. 21 incidents of haemorrhage.
- 3. None.
- 4. 3 incidents of severe bleeding.
- 5. 1 appendicectomy.
- 6. None.
- 7. I have not been provided with a copy of HM(68)8. If you could send me a copy I would try to give you any general or specific comments on how its provisions are working out.
