Dear ^KShaw,

Dr. Revans has been in correspondence with Dr. Rowe, of this Department, about the establishment of a centre for haemophiliacs in North Hampshire, initially at Treloar Hospital, Alton; and in his letter of 21 May requested an additional revenue allocation in support of it.

I am now writing to say that the Department agrees to provide an additional recurring allocation on revenue account to support this development. Up to £5,000 in respect of the appointments specified in Dr. Revans' letter of 21 May may be claimed as an additional allocation in revised estimates for the current year, entering the amount in column 2 of the revised estimate reconciliation statement. The total amount required for the appointments, within a limit of £7,000, should be claimed in revised estimates for 1972/73, stating the figures in columns 2 and 3 of the reconciliation statement. This letter should be quoted as authority.

We should like to have an informal report on the centre at an appropriate time.

I am enclosing copies of this letter for Dr. Revans and Mr. F.H.S. Connell, the Board's Treasurer.
