You may be interested to note the present state of play, with our thinking on this submission. Jonathan and I have been redrafting this over the last couple of days and feel that the £400k is reasonable - but would be grateful for your confirmation (or otherwise?) that it is affordable in the current budget planning. It is, of course, much less than they are asking for and it may be helpful for MS(PH) to have some negotiating room on this figure if this is possible. You may be interested to note that we now have 2 registrants enquiring about their legal status with regards to a waiver they should have signed before registering with the MFT, agreeing not to sue the Govt. Both we and the MFT are having problems finding copies of these waivers.
