This 30 year old engineer was involved in a road traffic accident when on holiday in Norway on 18.8.86., just outside Bergen. He sustained the following injuries:-

1. Spiral fracture, mid shaft of right tibia and spiral fracture lower end right fibula.
2. Fractured necks of the 2-3-4 metatarsals with displacement.
3. Subluxation of the calcaneo cuboid joint.

The tibial fracture was internally fixed using an inter locking system on the day of his admission to hospital in Bergen. The metatarsal fractures were internally fixed using K. wires on 28.8.86. The calcaneo cuboid joint was also fixed using K. wires. He was in hospital in Norway for 16 days and was discharged home when he had made a good initial recovery.

He was seen in the A & E Department of this hospital on 4.9.86. and was reviewed in clinic today. He is fairly comfortable but does complain of some discomfort over the plantar aspect of the right foot near the bases of his toes. He has a good range of movement in the right knee but the right foot is quite swollen and there is some stiffness of the right ankle and sub talar joint. The sutures have been removed from his right foot today and the wound appears to have healed satisfactorily. He will now commence intensive physiotherapy to mobilise the right foot and he should remain non weight bearing until we see him again in two weeks' time.
