He is fairly comfortable but does complain of some discomfort over the plantar aspect of the right foot near the bases of his toes. He has a good range of movement in the right knee but the right foot is quite swollen and there is some stiffness of theright ankle and sub talar joint. The sutures have been removed from his right foot todayand the wound appears to have healed satisfactorily. He will now commence intensive physiotherapy to mobilise the right foot and he should remain non weight bearing until we see him again in two weeks' time.
