HAEMOPHILIA SOCIETY

1. I enclose a copy of the note made by Mr Grimstone following Minister's recent meeting with the Society (which I was asked at the last minute to attend).

- 2. In regard to 2(iii), the Society representatives were clearly impressed by their visit to Dr Cleghorn's unit at Edgware, which they reported to contain (for plasmaphoresis) "a panel of 500-600 who were bled weekly". This was said to have been operating for eight years; its expansion was limited by shortage of technicians. I explained that there were professional differences of opinion about this process, though the brief note does not record this.
- 3. Or Owen asked me to let him have a copy of "the MAC report" from which the Society were quoting (they mentioned Dr Rosemary Biggs). Could you have a word with Dr Waiter and let me have a note, with the Report if available, fairly soon?
- 4. 2(iv); this was a spontaneous offer by Dr Owen; bearing in mind DHSS Ministers' general views on "the consumer voice" I think we have no option. I tentatively agreed with Mr Polton afterwards that we might have the first meeting early next summer (possibly in May); the Society would wish it to follow one of their own regular quarterly meetings. We can consider the arrangements later.
- 5. On 3, Dr Owen expressed personal acquaintanceship with Dr Hardisty (whom the Society thought highly of). Could you let me have a draft letter setting out present policy and giving the up-to-date position (ie on the lines of a normal MP letter), agreed with Dr Waiter.
