On Wednesday 9 July the Additional Report on compensation will be available from 11.00am to participants and their recognised legal representatives under a [Restriction Order](#). This access can be in person at Westminster Chapel, or remotely online.

Participants and their recognised legal representatives are welcome to arrive at any point during the morning. You will be able to come and go as you wish, though nobody will be able to take the Additional Report outside until after publication at 12.30pm.

Participants attending Westminster Chapel will receive a hard copy of the Additional Report. Anyone planning to access the Additional Report online through Egress at Westminster Chapel must bring their own device, and ensure that it is fully charged.

Refreshments: Tea and coffee will be available throughout the day and lunch will be provided.

Privacy: We understand that many of you will want to take photos. Please take particular care to ensure that you only include people in your group in any photos to protect the identity and privacy of others attending.

Media: Sir Brian Langstaff's statement will be filmed and live streamed on YouTube. People attending will not be shown on camera. Journalists will be wearing yellow lanyards for identification. Broadcast and print media have been requested not to film people without their permission. They will not be filming individuals in the Main Auditorium but they will conduct interviews in specific areas of the venue and outside the building.

Psychological Support: The Inquiry's British Red Cross team will be available at the venue (the phone line will also be operating).

Venue Accessibility: Westminster Chapel is between St James's Park Underground Station and Victoria Station. The entrance to Westminster Chapel is accessible via the main entrance on Buckingham Gate, with a ramp leading to the main doors.

Expenses: Please note that due to the timings of the event, the Inquiry will not reimburse the cost for accommodation unless you live more than 3 hours from the event venue. Details of allowable expenses for attending the event, and how to claim them, can be found [here](#).

Hearing loop: Hearing loops will be available in the Main Auditorium.

Luggage: Coats and luggage can be stored securely and you can leave your copy of the Additional Report at registration if you are going outside.

First Aid: There will be a First Aider at the venue.

Fire arrangements: In the event of a fire, please keep calm - staff from the venue and Inquiry will guide you from the building.
