

28.11.80 Treated today with CryoX10 for epistaxis.
 Developed a moderately severe transfusion
 reaction — generalised erythema, urticaria
 + rigor, which was abated with hydrocortisone
 (Piriton had been given before infusion).
 His future treatment should be changed
 to NHS factor VIII concentrate — try
 700u in first instance. Precede with
 Piriton and obtain baseline LFTs + Hb_s Ag
 pre treatment. If concentrate is used,
 weekly LFTs need to be obtained for
 8 weeks after first infusion. Also consider
 use of immunoglobulin — discuss with
 Dr Keroff when need for treatment arises.
