## EVALUATION OF SCREENING TEST KITS FOR HTLV III ANTIPODY

In his press release dated 27 June the Minister for Health announced that a test would be introduced to screen all blood given by blood donors for antibodies to the virus which causes AIDS. Arrangements would also be made for Seyually Transmitted Diseases clinics to provide a test for people who fear they may have been exposed to the disease.

The Department has funded the PHLS to set up laboratory facilities to confirm the results of any blood donations found positive in the Mational Blood Transfusion Service, and to test the samples taken in STD clinics. However, recipients of this letter are asked to ensure that copies are passed to all those who might be involved in the supply and use of test bits.
