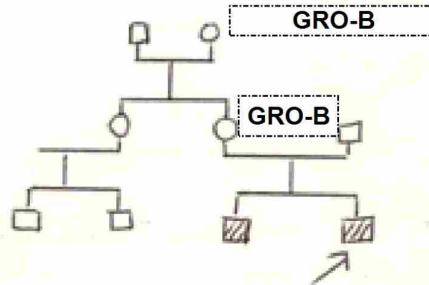

Severe haemophilia A - transferred to our care from GRO-B

General health: mild hay fever.
Hepatitis at the age of 5. No jaundice.

On home treatment - mother treats him. Has occasionally done it himself.

Because of 'cut backs' can't go swimming with school.

Joints: Main longstanding problem - rt. ankle (site of ? cut down as infant). Swells when used a lot. Occasional aches but good range of movement. Acute bleeds - most often rt. ankle. Mild limitation of movement and effusion.

All other joints okay.
