15 yr old severe haemophilia A
transfused from GOS.

Already seen in orthopaedic clinic —
needs supplementary C. brace.

Attending with ^mg/mother (GRO-C).

Chronic problems: L brace & R elbow.
Other joints good.

On home treatment — mother usually
treats but he is leaving. Last 3/12 —
about 2 doses/week on average for
miscellaneous joint bleeds & epistaxis. Was
advised to have short periods of Apixyluxin
for epistaxis. (Had several contraindications).
Normally used 4-6 ovals.
On Armour / WMS.

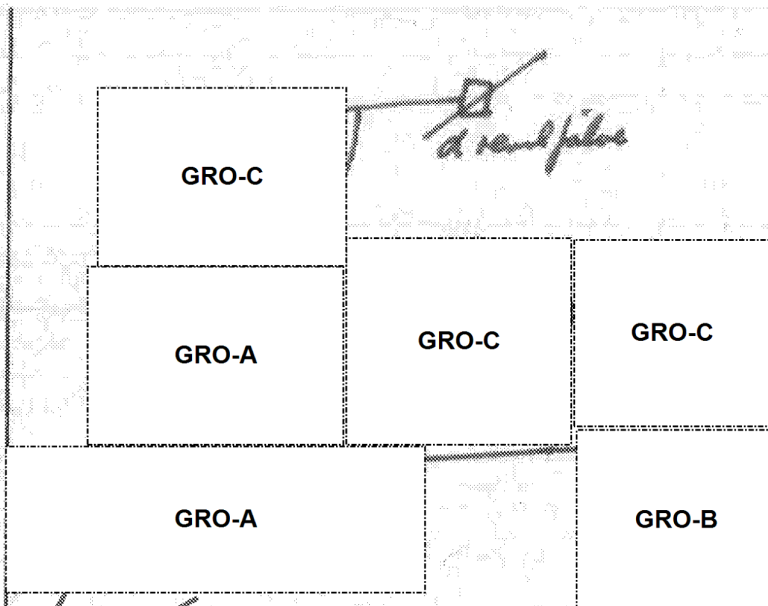
General health:
