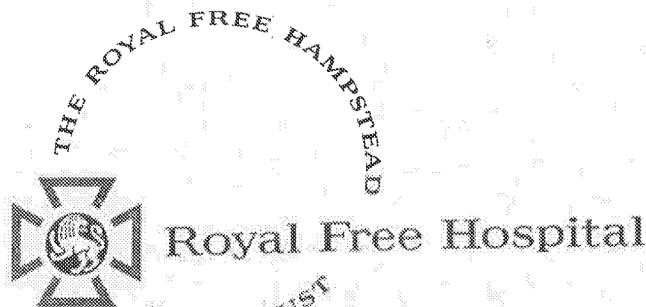

This 25 year old man with severe haemophilia A came for follow-up on 22nd January. He saw the duty psychiatrist who felt that he had much improved and has referred him for longterm counselling with our AIDS counsellor.

He has severe immunodepression from his HIV infection and his CD4 count is less than 50/ $\mu$ l. For this reason, he has been put on prophylaxis with fluconazole 150 mg weekly, co-trimoxazole 960 mg three times weekly and zidovudine 400 mg daily. Unfortunately I omitted to put him on clarithromycin 500 mg bd as prophylaxis against MAI but, I will make sure he is started on this when he attends next time.

I am very pleased to report that he is much improved - you will remember that he had a haematemesis at the beginning of January and was found to have a mouthful of candida. His mouth is now very healthy looking and he himself is much improved mentally. He is planning to go back to work on 1st February and he is currently living in **GRO-C** with friends but, he also has a flat in **GRO-C** which is convenient for his work.

I will see him again in two months' time.
