We reviewed Mr Mark Ward for the first time in the Combined Liver/Haemophilia Clinic on 3rd August 2004. He is HIV and HCV positive with genotype-3 HCV. He is currently on Nevirapine; Tenofovir; Ritonavir; and Indinavir. He has not had a biopsy. He has had little alcohol in recent years but may have had some in the past. I note that his transaminases were quite elevated in 2001 before he left for Birmingham but these are now normal recently. He has had a recent ultrasound, which does not show varices but shows a high hypoechoic liver.

He is anti-HBs positive.

We discussed the prospects of treatment with pegylated alpha-2a Interferon and Ribavirin. He has about a 50 percent chance of clearing hepatitis C and does need to give some thought to this. This would add considerable imposition to his treatment but may be worth it if he can clear the virus. I do not believe he needs a liver biopsy to proceed to therapy. Mr Ward will consider this.
