We reviewed Mr Mark Ward in the Combined HIV/Haemophilia Clinic on 21st December 2004. I am pleased to report that he is well and that his renal function is now returning to normal with a normal creatinine and a urea of 7.6. I do note that his lipids are elevated and I am arranging for us to do fasting lipids. We may change his anti-retroviral therapy because of this. However, I have suggested that we should await his knee replacement and I will review him in February when we will make a decision.
