This young gentleman with known haemophilia was admitted, allegedly having been assaulted and sustaining bruising to his abdomen. He underwent a CT scan which showed contusion in the upper abdomen. On the advice of the haematologists, he was given factor 8 during his stay. He initially reported that he had fallen off his sofa and had hurt his foot and ankle but later admitted to having been assaulted. His symptoms settled with analgesia.
