ENHANCED CT SCAN OF ABDOMEN AND PELVIS

No hepatic, splenic, renal, adrenal, pancreatic or biliary lesion is seen. The urinary bladder is very full. No abnormal fluid collection is identified. No free gas to indicate perforation is seen. The lung bases are clear. No bony lesion is seen. Abdominal wall musculature is unremarkable.

There is evidence of some contusion within the upper abdominal mesentery.
