Your patient was initially brought up to the Haemophilic Unit complaining of a very tender perianal region for 4 days. On examination - he had an obvious perianal abscess and arrangements were made for this to be incised and drained. In view of his previous mild haemophilia, he received IMVP infusion and tranexamic acid orally 1 gm 3 x a day. He also received human factor B to cover the procedure. He was taken to theatre the same day where a superficial small perianal abscess was drained. He had no episode of bleeding and was discharged home with a clinic appointment for 4 weeks time.
