GRO-A

The above patient was readmitted to Ward 4 on the 30.1.70. with a further bleed into his right knee joint. In view of the importance of this knee joint to GRO-A everyday life and well being, and in consideration of the fact that he had received no cryoprecipitate for at least one year, we decided to treat him with Factor VIII concentrate on this occasion. I am glad to see that he had no local response to his infusion, and he rapidly attained haemostatic levels of his circulating Factor VIII. The laboratory response of his Factor VIII level was mirrored in the immediate improvement in his clinical condition. The acute stages of his haemarthrosis subsided and prior to discharge he was treated with the usual physiotherapy and attended hydrotherapy daily. On the 9th February, he had a fresh "Plastazote" splint made for his knee joint and he was discharged.

We will be happy to review him as the occasion demands.
