Dear Dr. Maycock,

We have had a report of a case of jaundice in a haemophiliac. This haemophiliac received cryoprecipitate prepared from 8 units of blood and a number of doses of Factor VIII concentrate - Batch No. HL 1378.

I enclose a photocopy of the Hepatitis Form as submitted by the hospital, which gives the dates of the various transfusions and the possible incubation period. So far the Australia antigen tests are negative and, as yet, I am not very convinced that this is a transfusion transmitted jaundice.

We will get on with re-testing the donors of the cryoprecipitate and I will be sending you a proper report form in due course, but I thought you would want to know as soon as possible about the possible implication of your E.H.F.
