From the records dating back to when the College started at Froyle (not included pre NHS time at the hospital) there have been 219 students with haemophilia on roll (since about 1952/54 to present day, but last one was probably a few years back now: GRO-A P) Of these 219 there are bound to be lots who have died, but I have no way of knowing as I only know about those since my time.

Not sure how many of the above went to Alton College, 12 as far as I remember. Apart from those with dates next to them (indicating when they were at the College) all the others are since my time here, i.e. from 1976 to present time. This is from memory and those whose parents/friends have told us, I have no official way of knowing who has died. I am attempting to ask for help from The Macfarlane Trust to check against my names. In 1984 we had 28 boys with haemophilia, in 1995 this had reduced to 5. Presently we have none.
