Subject: MSPT2 waivers

Dear Zubeda

I know that your life is being made worse by a number of requests for copies of the waiver of litigation rights signed by all recipients of the MSPT2 settlement payments in 1991 before they could actually receive the money.

It is a source of great mystery to me why those documents are not on the individuals' files, which I understand are under your care. (Earlier this year I mistakenly thought it was the complete files that had gone missing, and asked Charles Lister for any suggestions as to their whereabouts; later I learned that you had them safe and relatively sound, the problem being absence of the waivers).

To my mind the absence of the waivers should not worry those who are pressing for them, since if they cannot be found that is one obstacle out of the way if they want to pursue their causes. But I know they do not see it that way.

I have been approached specifically by GRO-C and GRO-C to ask if I can help them. Are you able to assure me that you have MSPT2 files in respect of these two chaps which show that

the payments were made, but do not contain their waivers?

(2) I have been trying to think if there might be some pattern in this. Can you, similarly, tell me whether you have MSPT2 files in respect of **GRO-C** and **GRO-C**? Do they include the waivers?

The former might - like **GRO-C**'s and **GRO-C**'s - have been counter-signed by me, as an MSPT2 trustee. The latter will not have been. There is a logic in my choice of those names.

(3) If those files do not contain the waivers either, can you give me the names of anybody on whose files the waivers do appear?

I am not sure what "right" I have to seek this information, except that I was and remain a trustee of MSPT2 and authorised most of the payments, which were made over a very short period of time and needed some intensive effort by the trustees in going through all the applications. I distinctly recall the need to see and counter-sign the waiver in each case - and the MSPT2 Trust Deed confirms this necessity. So the absence of the documents now is a real puzzle.

Sorry to bother you with this. I hope you are well and have had a good summer. I am just back from a week in Turkey and really notice how autumnal the mornings have become.
