Simon - Following our discussion yesterday, SofS had received the attached letter from Lord Archer and a reply has been requested by Pr Off, by tomorrow. I am not at all clear how I should respond, given that this is not an independent inquiry in the normal sense and we are therefore, I assume, not obliged to take any part in the proceedings. However, the department would not wish to appear uncooperative, for obvious reasons. In his letter Lord Archer appears to be requesting that a DH representative appears before his inquiry. Can you advise on what action we should take, if any, and provide a form of words which I could use when replying to Lord Archer?

Wendy - is this something your branch can advise on? Have there been any precedents for inquiries such as the one proposed?

Gregory - you will wish to be aware.

Copy recipients - I would be grateful for any advice anyone may have. It is clearly important that we cooperate where possible however, we do need to be very careful and ensure that we do

not become involved in an inquiry "through the back door" given that ministers across the UK have consistently declined requests for an inquiry.

I will copy yesterday's lines to take and briefing on this to those who did not receive it.

I would appreciate views at your earliest convenience please.
