However, you might also want to let the APPG on Haemophilia know? Chair is Eddie O'Hara MP (President is Lord Morris of Manchester).

APPG members are very active in this area, and have asked several PQs & made FOI requests.

MS(PH) wrote to the APPG in addition to Lord Archer and the Haemophilia Society, when the finding of vCJD in a haemophilia patient was leaked to the press recently.

Let me know if you would like to include the APPG.

Patrick has already prepared versions of the commercial documents with company names and other identifiers redacted. This is line with advice from lawyers.

**Patrick** - grateful if you could prepare draft letters for Liz. (I'll send you contact details for Chris James separately).

**Konrad** - please liaise with Patrick on website requirements, (including location on website so that a web address can be included in the letters), and make arrangements with the DH web team for publication this week. I don't know what their usual timescales are, but you may need emphasise the need to get this done quickly. Let me know if you encounter any problems.

Can you / Patrick draft these letters for me please. They will need to make clear where on the website these documents can be found. Will we have a separate section for them to make them easy to access?

Also, you will need to be absolutely clear on the position re redaction ie are we going to redact company names or not? We should only do so if that is what we would do if we had had an FOI request for these documents. (bearing in mind that we may well get an FOI request if we do redact the names.....)

I would like the letters to go out this week - and the documents to be published on the website this week. Will that be OK?
