Alison Rogers, Director of the British Liver Trust, wrote to CMO, 20th April concerning the Hepatitis C Look back exercise.

Whilst making no overt criticism of the exercise her letter suggested that there were a number of issues arising which need to be resolved and suggested a meeting.

The letter followed an article in the Independent 18 April in which Ms Rogers was reported as being highly critical of the way the exercise had been conducted. We do not know the background to this.

The BLT's interests are of course much wider than this one exercise and they may be using this to get into more general discussion with the Department. They are, or could be, a useful ally in the care of those affected by liver disorder. In the context of the look back we have publicly committed ourselves to supporting good value for money initiatives by self help groups. However the BLT have yet to prove themselves and find their place.

I understand that CMO is not keen to meet them himself. I suggest that you chair a meeting with support from those directly involved with the look back work and supplement this team if necessary when you have seen exactly what they want to talk about.
