I saw **GRO-B** today the 16th of March. He had come because he was very concerned about hepatitis C infection. He had been reviewed on the 31st of August by Dr. Yee and had understood apparently for the first time that he was PCR negative although antibody positive. He was extremely upset about this because he says that he had never realised he was a "natural clearer".

I have discussed this further with him and I think he now has a clear understanding that he is one of the very few patients who were co-infected with HIV and HCV who have been fortunate enough to clear the hepatitis C completely and to be persistently PCR negative.
