CT Liver dual phase :

The liver appears enlarged and is not frankly cirrhotic on CT.

Areas of focal fat are present and there is a small simple cyst in segment 4.

The main portal vein is patent, there is no ascites or evidence of portal hypertension.

The remaining upper abdominal solid viscera are normal, there is no lymph node enlargement.

Conclusion:

No definitive evidence of frank cirrhosis on CT.
