We write to advise that we are now instructed by Mrs **GRO-B** in respect of this matter. The matter was temporarily transferred to Irwin Mitchells Solicitors (following the closure of Pubic Law Solicitors) because of the ill health of the conducting solicitor. Ms Ashton has now returned to work and has taken back conduct of the case in her employment at Central England Law Centre. The case reference is as given above.

In accordance with your directions made at the last PIR on <u>12 September 2014</u>, written submissions have now been made on behalf of Mr and Mrs**GRO-B** and the Department of Health following publication of the Penrose Report. We confirm that we have been provided with a copy of the Department's submissions.

You indicated that, at this stage, you would consider reconvening the PIR which was adjourned on that date and we are writing to request that you do so for the purpose of making a decision about the nature and scope of the enquiry to be undertaken. The Department of Health's submissions were made with the benefit of prior consideration of those submitted on behalf of Mr and Mrs **GRO-B** but the family have had no opportunity to respond.
