Re: GRO-B

Further to my letter of 19 January 1979 this 18 year old obligate carrier of the bleeding disorder Christmas Disease had a daughter GRO-B ago with no bleeding problems. When she was admitted for delivery her factor 2 level was only slightly below the lower limit of normal and therefore we did not give her any plasma.

I explained to Mrs GRO-B that there is a 50 - 50 chance of her daughter being a carrier and that we test her daughter when she is an adolescent. I have also suggested that when she becomes pregnant again we should see her and keep in touch as regards the possible requirement for treatment of any bleeding complications of future pregnancies.
