I am sorry to hear that you have got the diagnoses hepatitis C. During your hospitalstay in Bergen you received blood from 4 donors. The Haukeland University Hospital Bloodbank started hepatitis C-testing in October 1990. In 1986 the hepatitis C virus was unknown and consequently there was not any test available.

We have examined through our donorfiles. Three of the four donors have tested anti-hepatitis C negative. The fourth donor has not given blood since 1987, and she has not tested hepatitis C positive as a patient.
