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GRO-A was reviewed in our follow up clinic today. I am pleased to report that both knees and elbows show improved ranges of movement and his ankles have slightly improved since his hydrocortisone injections.

He had what appeared to be an episode of jaundice about six weeks ago and this was associated with loss of appetite and nausea. This lasted about three weeks and he has been well since. I presume that he had an episode of transfusion-related hepatitis and hopefully the matter has now resolved.

We will be doing the appropriate blood chemistries.

He is realistic about AIDS and feels as I do that the benefits of treatment far outweigh the small risk of acquiring this condition.

We will review him again in six months time.
