It was a pleasure to meet you last Thursday and I would like to thank you for the useful information you gave me relating to your centre.

I would like to confirm to you the three different potencies of Koate (concentrated ractor VIII) available from Cutter Laboratories.

250 i.u. 10 ml. diluent 560 i.u. 20 ml. diluent 1000 i.u. 40 ml. diluent

The i.u. quoted are nominal value.

The highest potency material is particularly useful to the haemophiliac requiring large doses, i.e. for surgery.

The number of bottles can be reduced fourfold against the 250 i.u. side vial. Reducing the manipulations required for reconstitution and administration being of particular advantage to the clinician and the patient.

I hope this information is useful and that the high potency Koate will be of value to your centre in the future.
