Supplies of Factor VIII Concentrate

You will have received a copy of Dr. C.L. Scott's letter of 2nd July.

BPL is very gradually increasing the amounts of concentrate fractionated and I would like to help Dr. Scott if possible. However, on looking at the plasma receipt record, the number of packs of frozen fresh plasma received from Bristol fell from 115 in the first quarter to 66 in the second quarter. I do not think we can make good the 200 "Cryos" a month mentioned by Dr. Scott, but we could perhaps let him have the equivalent of a hundred. However, we could not do even this unless we can be assured that the Bristol contribution will rise again to about 100 - 120 packs per quarter and, ideally, above this.

Would you let me know what your forecast is, as I would like to reply to Dr. Scott. I have ^{not} sent him a copy of this letter.
