The role of the BPL and PF Lab should continue to be to prepare so-called intermediate anti-haemophilic globulin concentrate and leave the provision of so-called superconcentrate to commercial producers because of the uneconomical nature of the process involved in preparing the latter fraction.

If circumstances change, this arrangement might be reconsidered.
