

Mr. Butterfill asked the Secretary of State for Scotland if Scotland is already self-sufficient in blood products; for how long the heat treating of all concentrates has been taking place, and if he will make a statement.

Mr. John MacKay: Scotland is self-sufficient in all normally required blood products. All factor VIII concentrate issued from the protein fractionation centre of the Scottish national blood transfusion service since I January 1985 has been heat treated.
