## Dear Roger

Thank you for your letter of 19 March. I will of course be delighted to continue to engage directly with you in any area where it is appropriate to have chair-to-chair contact between Macfarlane and the Haemophilia Society, or indeed as a way of keeping in touch generally.

However, you should be aware that Liz Carroll continues to be the CEO of the Society with the full approval and support of our Board of Trustees, and in operational matters it is generally appropriate that she speaks directly with the Trust. I am confident that she and Jan will be able to work together professionally as needed in order to support the people who are the beneficiaries of both our charities.

I was not previously aware of your change of Trust Deed, and this is something which it would be useful to discuss chair to chair.
