Yes, we are inviting Lord Morris as a campaigning politician as opposed to his role as President of the Haemophilia Society. I don't know how his diary is fixed as yet. (As you are aware we keep completely separate from the Society and you will notice that no-one from the Society apart from Lord Morris was interviewed. Will Yates (programme producer) contacted the Society in the past for info for "Face The Facts" and found them most unhelpful, a lot of media realise now that the important information needed to campaign on this issue successfully does not come from their direction and are of course asking why! I have just listened to the programme on Radio 4 and I am sending you the link to the programme which Lord Owen can listen to at his convenience. The statement from Yvette Cooper at the end of the piece highlights how the DOH have got their facts wrong with regard to Eire, which I have pointed out to them many times. I don't think the DOH would have expected an interview from the Irish minister which backed the inquiry (Lindsay Tribunal held in Eire) and recent recompense strongly supporting justice for haemophiles. It further highlights the total shambles at this end. Lord Owen's call for the self-sufficiency issue to be investigated is featured and an interview from Lord Morris. All in all a very good piece!
